Dr Sasha warns of the dangers of Parvovirus

Parvovirus is a deadly disease and VERY contagious. As the name suggests, it is a virus, one that has many effects on the body. The virus invades the body's bone marrow where red blood cells and other immune fighting cells are produced, hence reducing the body's defence mechanisms, and invades and destroys the cells that line the small intestine, causing it to slough off. This is very painful for the dog, and allows nasty toxins from the gut to be absorbed into the dog's blood stream. All treatment is supportive, because unlike bacteria which can be treated with antibiotics, there are few anti-virals on the market which can help dogs affected by parvo-virus.



Dr Sasha Laws-King says no matter how big or small, young or old, your dog is, it needs to be up to date with Parvovirus vaccinations. "Treating Parvovirus is difficult due to the nature of the disease. Successful cases are diagnosed early on and aggressive supportive therapy initiated immediately," she

"It is incredibly contagious and we have a separate isolation area, highly qualified veterinary nurses and procedures in place to ensure the virus is not spread." Fortunately the disease is very easily controlled by keeping your pets up to date with their vaccinations.
